Alongside original members Niall Kelly (vocals & guitar), Jack Godley (percussion), and Shane Lynam (vocals & bass), the quintet delivers a bigger, bolder show packed with driving rhythms, soaring fiddle lines, and crowd-lifting anthems that are guaranteed to get everyone dancing under the open sky.
